

This weekend marks the holy days of Pentecost and Shavuot, two of the most important holy days to Christians and Jews It's not a simple coincidence that the two holidays fall at the same time.

## What do the sacred days have to do with each other? They're historically — and theologically — linked.

Shavuot falls on the sixth day of the Hebrew month of Sivan. Originally a harvest festival, today Shavuot commemorates the giving of the Torah at Mount Sinai. People gather to commemorate God's giving the Torah to the ancient Israelites. The holiday is one of the three Biblical pilgrimage festivals, the others being Sukkoth and Passover.

Shavuot is Hebrew for "weeks" and comes seven weeks from Passover. Pentecost is the Greek name for Shavuot and literally means "fiftieth day." Just as Passover is observed seven weeks from Shavuot, Believers observe the Pentecost seven weeks after Easter.

<u>In Acts 2</u> followers of Jesus were celebrating the Jewish festival of Shavuot and were "filled with the Holy Spirit."

In this way, both holidays deal with similar themes — the giving of divine knowledge. Philipians 1:27 "Only [be sure to] lead your lives in a manner [that will be] worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I do come and see you or remain absent, I will hear about you that you are standing firm in one spirit [and one purpose], with one [a]mind striving side by side [as if in combat] for the faith of the gospel." Amplified Bible
